You will need to remember four things for this day.


- 1. We will be putting our good works on display, so we need you to bring in any good woodturning projects that you have made that can be put on display.

Armistice Day Centenary Memorial Grant

The Blue Mountains Woodturners have been invited, by Federal Member Sue Templeton, to apply for a grant for the development and establishment of a community project to commemorate the centenary of Armistice Day in 2018.

We have been granted permission, in principle, by BMCC to develop a memorial pathway and gardens in Whiten Park adjacent to the Glenbrook Bowling Club. That area has been designated as a memorial site and our proposal complies with the zoning of the area.

More details will be provided as we progress, however we are asking all members to start now to grow Rosemary plants for use in the park. The project needs to get approval from the Federal Government and that won't be finalised until June 2018. We then have 4 months to complete the project. In that time we intend to build a group of wooden sculptures representing the armed services and medical corp as well as Peace.

We will be calling upon the members to participate in both the development of the pathway and gardens as well as the making of the sculptures. This should be an exciting project for everyone to be involved in that will promote our club as a dedicated community organisation. So, please don't over book yourselves for the latter half of 2018 - we may all be very busy.
