



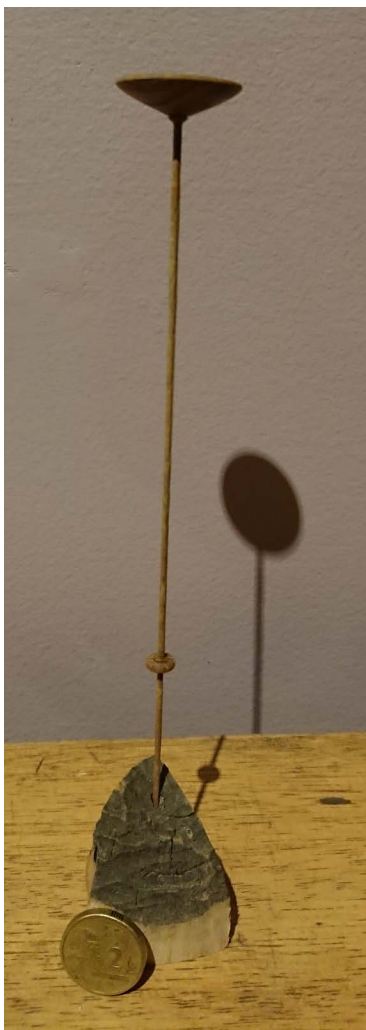

This goblet was turned by Rob Brent during a class here on Tuesday and Thursday. The stem is under 2mm in diameter. Length 200mm. Rob used a steady rest to hold the workpiece while he turned the top of the goblet and a string steady to support the top while turning the stem.
