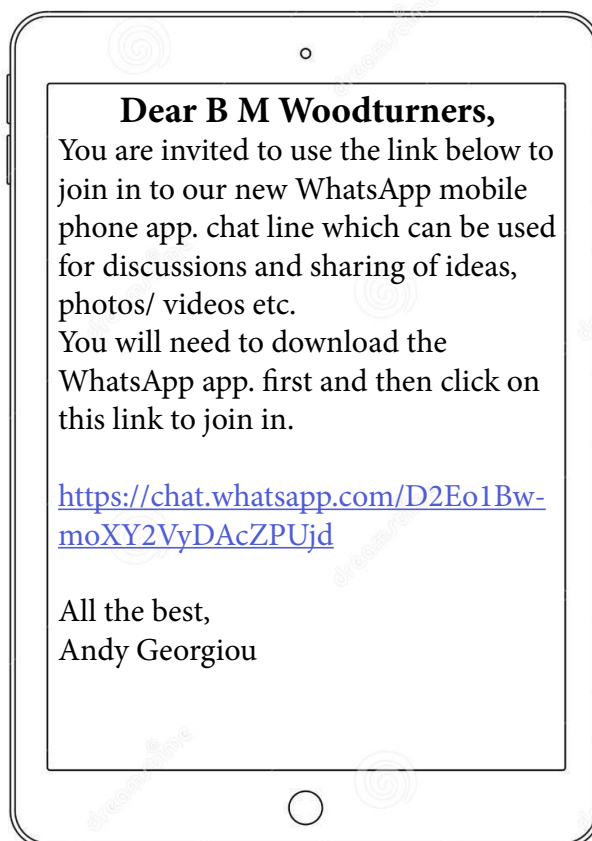

Toy day –Every Thursday

Note: TILL ROCKING HORSE IS COMPLETED

Katoomba Auxiliary.

- Toys for sale in Auxiliary shop: Some toys have been sold. They do attract attention, but few takers.
- Rocking Horse (Priority):
 - Head and body assembly is complete
 - Legs are almost done
 - Saddle: Requires a raised section to be added to the back. “Rob” is doing this at home
 - Rockers: After, band sawing rocker profile, timber was cracked and judged not fit for purpose. 35 x 90mm Pine has been cut in appropriate lengths, and will be glued together to form the shape of the rockers. “Allan” is doing this at home.
- R/H Delivery: Auxiliary has been advised that the R/H will not be delivered on the 10th September.
- **Standard toy production.**

The club will resume standard toy making once the R/H is delivered. This should take place during September.
